## 4. PLANNING APPLICATIONS:

**WD/2010/0454/F – LITTLE FOXES FARM, STONEHURST LANE, FIVE ASHES, TN20 6LL –** Erection of new dwelling and associated outbuildings, amendments to approved application WD/2008/0339/F. To include amendment to condition relating to demolition of existing dwelling, application seeks to retain this until new dwelling is constructed. - The Parish Council cannot support this application due to the excessive height of the building on a ridge which will be easily seen from a distance. The Parish Council consider the associated outbuildings to be overdevelopment of this site, in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

WD/2010/0679/F - 15 STANDEN MEWS, HADLOW DOWN, TN22 4HG - Proposed rear conservatory - The Parish Council support this application

**WD/2010/0626/F** – **ST MARKS C OF E PRIMARY SCHOOL, SCHOOL LANE, TN22 4HY** – Addition of an entrance canopy to the main entrance area – The Parish Council support this application, we consider this an improvement to the school in terms of usability and security. The school plays an important part in the village community of Hadlow Down.
