## **County Council Report to Hadlow Parish Council Aug 2020**

## Covid

Covid not surprisingly is a still a dominant feature. As previously reported the cases in East Sussex are below the national average with 290.8 per 100k population against a national figure of 465. However, the effect on communities is still significant with many businesses and households struggling to get back to "normal".

ESCC together with neighbouring authorities and B and B have contingency plans for how to deal with any localised outbreaks.

## Recovery

Team East Sussex (the East Sussex part of the federated SELEP) are finalising the East Sussex Recovery Plan. This details the Action Plan in short, medium and longer term and also brings together the work of the Districts and Boroughs.

## Budget

Whilst work has started on the budget for 21-22 it will be difficult to finalise until we know the position on Govt Funding and how much of the costs incurred on Covid will be re-imbursed.
