<u>Highways:</u> The roads/lanes south of the A272 and the section of the A272 running from the New Inn to the A267 have been thoroughly inspected in preparation for the SLR meeting later this month. Report written. Two specific issues have been reported including the serious deterioration around a manhole outside Southlands.

<u>Footpaths</u>: A number of concerns have been raised by local residents over access to both designated and non-designated footpaths (including HAD/38/1 between Woodlands Farm and Hole Farm, and HAD/28/1 close to Canters End). These concerns are being followed up.

<u>Other:</u> A number of residents have raised concerns over the impact of traction engines and the like on the surfaces of local roads and the flow of traffic during events. No action has yet been taken.

<u>SID</u>: Work has continued to try to progress installation of a speed indicator display sign. The site licenses have recently been agreed by ESCC and hopefully erection of the poles will take place shortly.
