SID: Routine battery changes and data download (every two weeks).

The third site for the SID (adjacent to the top entrance to the Church on the A272) has now been 'up and running' since 20th March (a brief analysis of the data collected is shown below- many thanks to Steve Godfrey for his help with this). The 'working day' and 'weekend / bank holiday' data show some significant differences –a greater % of 'w/e and b/h' vehicles travelling over the speed limit.

A second 'Speed Indicator Sign' (SID) was ordered some weeks ago and delivery is imminent.
