



PARISH POLL COUNT RESULTS

The Parish Poll was held on Tuesday 9th September 2025 between 15:00 – 21:00 in the Hadlow Down Village Hall.

The Parish Poll count was held on Wednesday 10th September 2025. It was undertaken by the Parish Clerk, Vicki Rutt and overseen by an independent Clerk, Emma Neil of Burwash Parish Council.

The current number on the electoral roll in Hadlow Down, as of September 2025, is 636.

The Parish Council agreed that in order for the Parish Poll to be a satisfactory response, a 20% turnout is needed. This is a response of 127 votes.

A total of 268 votes were received which is a 42% response.
