YOU could be in at the 'grass roots' level of Local Government and be involved in making things happen or getting things sorted!

YOU could get local views about local issues brought to the attention of the powers that be.

You need to be able to give up normally one evening a month to attend Parish Council meetings, and some additional hours in order to undertake Councillor responsibilities depending on portfolio. In return you will receive the satisfaction of knowing that you are helping your local community.

Candidates must be at least 18 years of age and be included in the Electoral Register. They must be a British subject or a European national and must satisfy at least **one** of the following:

- have, during the whole of the previous 12 months, occupied land or other property in the parish, either as owner or tenant
- have, during the whole of the previous 12 months, had your principal or only place of work in the parish;
- have resided in the parish, or within 3 miles of its boundary, during the whole of the previous 12 months

The Parish Council normally meets on the first Tuesday of the month at 7pm. New Councillors will hold office until the next local elections in May 2027.
