



FEES AND CHARGES IN RESPECT OF THE BURIAL GROUND, HADLOW DOWN

The Fees and Charges laid out below are for grave plots not exceeding 9' x 4' in size, or in the case of cremated remains, 2' x 2'.

Parishioners are residents of Hadlow Down or those deemed to be eligible by the Parish Council, that is persons who currently appear on the electoral register for the parish of Hadlow Down or were on it up to a maximum of eighteen months prior to their death and have in the meantime been in a nursing home outside the parish. Evidence may need to be provided to the Parish Council.

Walled graves or vaults are not available in this Burial Ground.

GRAVE DIGGING — The Parish Council does not undertake grave digging and the cost is not covered in the above fees. All grave digging must be arranged with the appropriate Funeral Director or with a private contractor. If the grave will be over one metre deep it will need to be shored beforehand. It is illegal for a grave digger to enter an excavation without shoring and to dig ahead of shoring. This again will need to be dealt with by the appropriate Funeral Director or with a private contractor. The plot for cremated remains should be dug deep enough to take 2 remains.
